Win Your Book Published Free Contest Rules

Urban City Publishing, LLC, a Detroit-based publishing company, presents its first public contest, the "Win Your Book Published Free Contest." These rules and regulations are meant to be used as a reference only, as instructions for those interested in entering the contest, and are not meant to be comprehensive.

Qualify to win your manuscript published free by Urban City Publishing.

1. Take any one chapter of your manuscript (the entire ms. does not need to be finished) and e-mail it in a compatible format to jjjustice@urbancitypublishing.com with the words "Contest Entry" in the subject line and the type of entry, either "Fiction", "Non-Fiction" or "Poetry". Compatible formats include .pdf, and .doc.
2. Pay the \$ 25 entry fee by using the PayPal link on the Website UrbanCityPublishing.com. Include the PayPal confirmation # in your emailed entry. You will receive a confirmation e-mail within 24hrs of receipt of your payment. The e-mail will confirm that your payment has been received and that you are officially entered into the contest.
3. Alternate method: Pay the \$ 25 entry fee by sending a check, money order or cashier's check payable to Urban City Publishing to the address below (also on the '[contact.html](#)' page of the Website UrbanCityPublishing.com). You will receive a confirmation e-mail within 24hrs of receipt of your payment. The e-mail will confirm that your payment has been received and that you are officially entered into the contest.
4. In the email body, be sure to have your first and last name and payment type used (including PayPal confirmation #). Optionally, add a brief synopsis of your work.
5. Those who do not win the Grand Prize (a.k.a. First Place) will earn a credit toward services from the offices of Urban City Publishing, LLC, including (but not limited to) manuscript appraisal, editing, and book publishing. A list of services offered can be found on the Website. Urban City Publishing is not liable for unclaimed entry fees not applied to services after the announcement of the winning entry. Entrants to this contest have 2 years from the date of announcement of the winning entry to claim their credits, should they not win the Grand Prize.
6. A panel of three professional members of the urban literary community will judge each entry and the First Place winner will receive their book published

free. The winner will then receive forty copies of their published book. The author of the winning entry will retain all rights to the winning manuscript.

7. The decisions of the judges of the contest will be final.
8. Urban City Publishing, LLC, owners and employees are excluded from participation in this contest, as are direct employees of other companies doing business directly with Urban City.
9. The entry fee and manuscripts may be submitted between July 30, 2010 and September 30, 2010. The winning manuscript will be announced November 30th, 2010. Entries will not be considered until both the entry manuscript and the entry fee are submitted and received by Urban City Publishing.

The First, Second and Third-Place finishers will also receive a framable certificate stating their place in the contest. The winning manuscript will be published March, 2011. If unfinished, the completed manuscript must be ready no later than December 31, 2010, for final editing.
